TASTING NOTES:

High-quality wine with an attractive clear cherry color. The nose emphasizes the aromatic intensity of red fruits, citrus fruits, mineral tones and licorice. In the mouth it is medium-body with soft tannins. Long, sweet and persistent in the beginning with an agreeable finish which stands out for its natural freshness.

FOOD PAIRING: Appetizers, all types of rice and pasta dishes, grilled red and white meat. Perfect for barbecues.
